Dear Praying Friends...Greetings from Ft Worth, Texas!

It was 8:30AM a couple of weeks ago when Vi's doctor called to give us the results of recent tests..."It is breast cancer" and I'm referring you to an oncologist surgeon!"

Over the previous week, my wife had had several tests subsequent to finding a suspicious lump. The surgery will be on June 3rd. Obviously our life's schedule has changed to accommodate the care Vi is going to need over the coming weeks. I know you will be praying...thank you!! Below is what my wife wrote up and has already sent to our family and some of you:

"Our new challenge: I have been diagnosed with breast cancer. It is treatable and I have met with the surgeon who will perform a partial mastectomy. It will probably be a day surgery and will only require chemotherapy in pill form, followed 4 weeks with radiation treatment.

I am constantly amazed that God's Word is so specific about living here on earth. Psalm 139:13-18 "For you formed my inward parts, you knitted me together in my mother's womb. I praise you for I am fearfully and wonderfully made. Wonderful are your works; my soul knows it very well. My frame was not hidden from you when I was being made in secret, intricately woven in the depths of the earth. Your eyes saw my unformed substance, in your book were written, every one of them, the days that were formed for me when as yet there was none of them. How precious to me are your thoughts, O God! How vast the sum of them. If I would count them, they are more than the sand. I awake, and I am still with you."

When I received the initial phone call saying "cancer," I went back to my journal that I started January 1 with the theme of HOPE. I reread the Scripture verses that related to hope and was greatly encouraged that God had been preparing me for this very day! I rejoiced that He would count me worthy to endure something new in order to make His glory known. My dear husband has been such a support as we have prayed through the "what if's" and we both have set our hope on Him alone.

The theme for this chapter of my life is found in Jeremiah 17:7-8 (see top of letter)

I am truly hoping to be able to go "home" to Schroon Lake for a few weeks this summer before beginning radiation. But for now, we are "camping" in Texas."

Vi and I don't want to waste this cancer experience and pray that as others watch our lives they too will be encouraged in whatever struggle they may be facing. I recently read this quote as a good reminder that we are the church before a watching world: "Anxious Christians are bad advertisements for the God of all comfort" - Matthew Chandler

Fiji Car Project — We introduced the need to equip our WOL Fijian director with a car which would enable him to reach majority of his country's population in the rural areas. The goal was \$12,000 to purchase a reliable used car. **The response has been super so far with a remaining balance of only \$3,200!** Thank you to those of you who have participated and pray with me that the Lord will soon meet this very real need. Pray for power of the Gospel to change Fijian youth and for our Kiwi team to also be impacted to serve our Savior for the rest of their lives in both the secular and sacred world.

We could not be entering our 47th year of ministry were it not for a faithful team partnering with us each and every month!
