Mei-Mei Lee was born in Hong Kong and came to the U.S. at the age of seven. Her love for children became evident after becoming a Christian at 14 years of age and served in the children's ministry through her local church. She received her B.A. in Child Development and taught in the public school for seven years. During her summers, Mei-Mei served as Summer Missionary with Child Evangelism Fellowship in the SF Bay Area and later in Hong Kong. While she was in Hong Kong, she had an opportunity to minister in Macau for a week, where she was able to witness and teach many children who were hungry for the Gospel.
